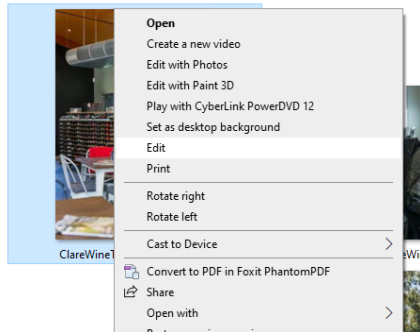
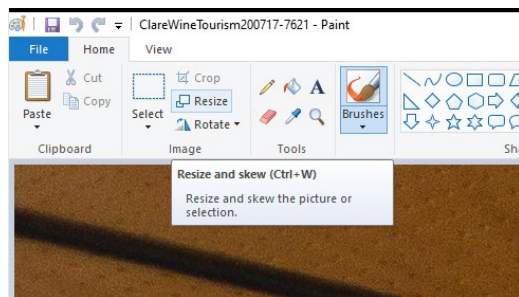


How to resize images for ATDW - Windows

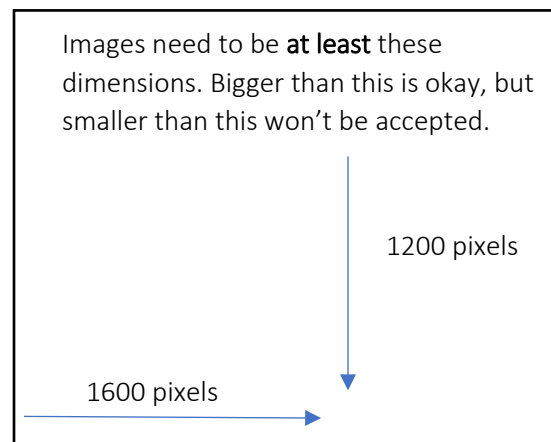
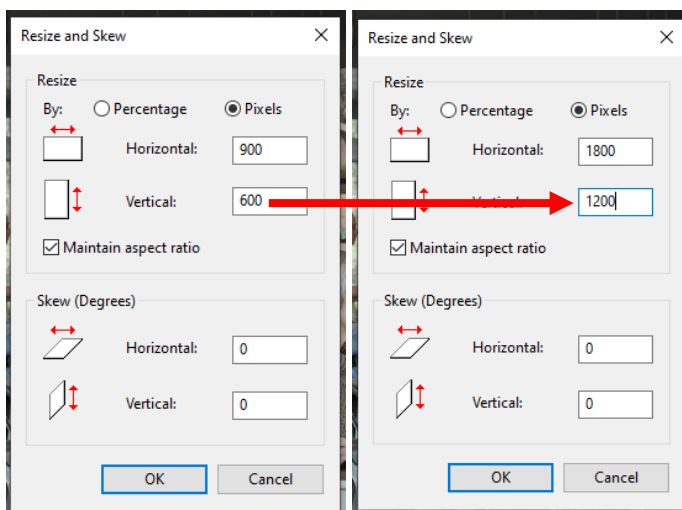
1. Right-click on the image you wish to resize. This will bring up this menu.



2. Click 'Edit' – this should open the image in Paint.
3. Firstly, if the image is portrait (long) then you will need to crop it to a landscape (wide). Use the select tool to outline the landscape section of the image, then click the crop tool.
4. Click 'Resize'



5. This will bring up this menu. It will default to change by Percentage, but you will need to change the 'resize by' to Pixels.



6. Change the smaller number to meet the requirements of ATDW (above). So in this scenario, the vertical dimensions would be changed to 1200. This automatically changes the other number to be larger than the minimum, therefore large enough for ATDW.
7. Remember to **SAVE AS** your image file so that the original is not overwritten.
